Advice has been received from our Regional Office in San Francisco that the City of Pacific Grove, California, is interested in acquiring 2.23 acres of land located at the Point Pinos Light Station, now a part of the U. S. Coast Guard Reservation at Pacific Grove, California. We are further advised that your office in the Twelfth Naval District has made a report that the 2.23 acres is excess to its needs.

It is our understanding that the City of Pacific Grove desires the subject property as a site for a sewage disposal plant. In view of the responsibility of this Agency under Public Law 152 for the disposal of surplus property for health and educational purposes, it would be appreciated if you would advise General Services Administration of our interests in this property, when and if it is reported to GSA as being excess to your needs.
