This office has received advice from the Regional Property Coordinator, San Francisco, that the City of Pacific Grove, California, is interested in acquiring 2.23 acres of land located at the Point Pinos Light Station, now a part of the U. S. Coast Guard Reservation at Pacific Grove, California. Steps are apparently being taken by the Coast Guard to report the subject property as excess to its need.

This is to advise you that if and when the subject property becomes surplus to the needs of the Government, assignment to this Agency will be requested for disposal to the City of Pacific Grove for health purposes as a site for a sewage disposal plant.
