Dear Sir:

The new quarters at Pt. Pinos Light Station, as inspected 14 April 1959, are acceptable to the Coast Guard. The subcontractor's written 10-year guarantee on the tile roof is acknowledged and also the oral advice by Mr. Savoldi of the Helm & Savoldi General Contractors, concerning a one-year guarantee against defective materials or workmanship.

A quotation from a local contractor is being requested for installation of water lines for the garden and lawn area. This will enable you to place top soil and seed the lawn including lawn care through the first cutting. The planting limits are now marked by corner stakes and are approximately 100 feet per side surrounding the new building. Room for foundation planting should be left at exterior walls.

Mr. Thomas at Monterey Coast Guard Station will remove movable Coast Guard equipment and turn over the existing apartment and outbuildings whenever you desire these buildings.

Your cooperation and assistance in completing these new quarters is greatly appreciated, and it is hoped that your new golf course will be playable this Fall.

A sketch of a carport will be forwarded as soon as practicable so that construction can be commenced when funds are available.
