Dear Lieutenant Bousquet:

This will acknowledge our recent telephone conversation regarding submission of Coast Guard properties to the National Register of Historic Places. In checking through our files, we have determined that the following sites have already been placed on the National Register of Historic Places: East Brother Light Station, Contra Costa County, and Point Fermin Lighthouse, Los Angeles County.

The following sites are pending on the National Register at this time: the Point Reyes Lighthouse and associated structures, Marin County; Point Reyes Lifesaving Station, Marin County; Pigeon Point Light Station, San Mateo County; Point Montara Light Station, San Mateo County; Point Sur Light Station, Monterey County; Point Pinos Light Station, Monterey County; and San Luis Obispo Light Station, San Luis Obispo County.

The following sites have been proposed for submission to the National Register by the 11th Coast Guard District. At this time, no official applications have been received: Point Loma Light Station, San Diego County; Ballast Point Coast Guard Moorings, San Diego County; Point Conception Light Station, Santa Barbara County; and Los Angeles Light Station, Los Angeles County.

Finally, the archeological site at the Point Cabrillo Light Station, Mendocino County, which is located on Coast Guard property, has been placed on the National Register of Historic Places. However, the lighthouse itself at Point Cabrillo is not on the National Register at this time.

We hope the enclosed information will be of some assistance to you in evaluating which properties you wish to pursue for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places. Please do not hesitate to contact this office if we may be of any further assistance.
