This is in reference to the Point Pinos Light Station Automation (SCH#74031192). Comments were received through the SCH from the State Park Archaeologist, Mr. RIDDELL. Coordination with Mr. RIDDELL provided more detailed information to the Coast Guard on archaeological values at Pt. Pinos and provided Mr. RIDDELL with further information on the project. During this process this office discovered an error in the Notice of Intent. The original notice reads remove excess machinery and buildings. A new Notice of Intent is being processed which states that the specific machinery is one diesel generator set (of no historic value - still in production) and the buildings will remain.
