

Among many visitors at Point Piños  
Lighthouse Sunday July 29, 1974 was R.N. Tucker  
the grandson of former keeper of the light,  
Charles Nelson. MR. Tucker struck a  
remarkable resemblance to his grandfather  
who had be in attendance at the historical  
site in 1934 along with his family. MR.  
Tucker described life in the lighthouse mentioning  
among his chores, milking the three  
family goats, tending chickens and doing his  
school work in the small front room which was  
heated by pine logs and ~~kerosene~~ bit. lit by kerosene lamp
