Subject: Point Pinos Lighthouse and "Procedural Guide for Grant Applications"

Dear Gary:

I have gone over the procedural guide for grant applications and find the same problems which you covered in your note to me of 2-26-76. The problem of greatest difficulty is that the city does not have ownership. The next serious difficulty is the fact that no federal funds may be used for matching. This is somewhat ameliorated by our option to use "in kind" matching i.e. - administration, city labor and equipment etc. While this latter is not spelled out as such, it works with other federal funding.

I will be talking with Mr. Paul Perrot, Assistant Secretary for Museum Programs, Smithsonian Institution, this week while in Baltimore. He served as chairman of the President's Special Committee which recently scored the army for its "willful neglect" of the Dutton Hotel in southern Monterey County. As you know this brought about a quick transfer of that property to the Monterey County Parks Department. Perhaps Paul will have some suggestions.
