Dear Lt. Desbrow:

Earlier in the month, I telephoned to discuss the proper procedure for the City of Pacific Grove to install a concrete walkway at the Pt. Pinos Light Station. The walkway would be from the dirt parking lot to the edge of the black-top road which circles the Pt. Pinos Light Station.

You said that a simple map indicating the area involved would be the proper procedure. I have therefore Xeroxed a portion of a Coast Guard map which best indicates the area.

Essentially, the location is alongside the white fence that parallels the roadway entrance to the Light Station. We can install whatever break joints that may be required should the walkway cross underground wiring which might need future replacement.

The proposal is therefore that the City of Pacific Grove be permitted to install a concrete walkway, three feet wide and approximately 100 feet long, in the area marked on the map provided.
