Dear Lt. Desbrow:

Recently a pane of glass was broken in the Point Pinos Light tower and subsequently replaced by Coast Guard personnel. In the installation process, the brass handles which were attached to either side of the glass support were removed. They have not been reinstalled.

Because Point Pinos Light Station is one of the primary historical buildings of California, and is on the National Registry of Historic Places, I urge that the aforementioned original brass work be returned to the Lighthouse. They will otherwise be lost.
