Earlier this year you requested Coast Guard financial assistance for the removal of asbestos from the Point Pinos Lighthouse. I regret to inform you that we will not be providing any funds to assist in the asbestos removal project. Should the City decide to remove the asbestos, we recommend that all asbestos containing material be disposed of in accordance with all Federal, State and local regulations.

Your request to renovate the second floor of the lighthouse is under final environmental review. Final Coast Guard approval of the project may be contingent on California SHPO approval.
