Dear Chief Thornton:

To follow up on our telephone conversation of this date, I am requesting the key to the garage of one of the empty Coast Guard houses at Point Pinos Lighthouse.

As we discussed, we have obtained Coast Guard permission to remove asbestos floor tiling and replace it with tiling of other materials at the Lighthouse in preparation for producing a Coast Guard/Coast Watch exhibit in the Lighthouse.

In order to facilitate the removal of the asbestos tile and its replacement we would like permission to temporarily store (for about 2-3 weeks) some furniture and fixtures, e.g. the old kitchen stove and some exhibit material in one of the garages of the Coast Guard houses at Point Pinos.
