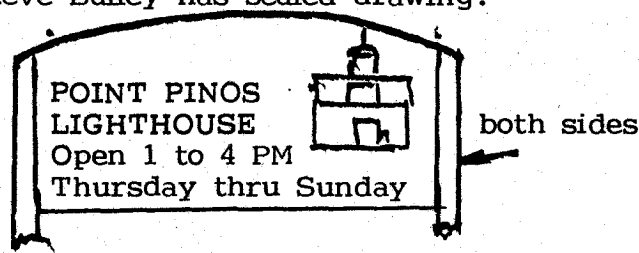


PT PINOS- RESTORATION PRIORITIES DEAN 12.30.97

1) LIGHTHOUSE SIGN

Construct carved lighthouse sign and mount to top of 9th hole tee fence. Steve Bailey has scaled drawing.



2) ENTERANCE SIGN

Add small carved entrance direction sign along side of historic monument plaque to direct visitors to front door.



3) COMPLETE COAST GUARD WATCH ROOM

4) COMPLETE BATHROOM

Enamel tub inside and out, install brass fixture, available at Renovators Supply. Install pedestal sink with brass fixture, available at Home Depot or Renovators Supply

5) CLEAN UP BASEMENT

Store ladder etc in Coast Guard area under stair well? Remove all trash. Remove rotten plywood floor. Grind granite surface flush or skin coat with cement. Refurbish Clock Work Mechanism. Install low voltage transformer to reduce brightness of 1,000 watt light and add a fractional horse power motor to rotate eclipser shield.

6) INSET GATES

Inset gates 12 inches for improved view of, Parlor, Bedroom and front watch room. Reference Paul Finnegan.

7) HANDICAP RAMPS. (Required by law)

Outside: Install door in place of window to kitchen. Provide cement ramp from back door walkway north turn around and south to new door level. Install period wrought iron railing.
Inside: Install ramp along west wall of kitchen to reception room door platform. Provide step for walking visitors. Install period wrought iron railing.

8) RECEIPTICAL AND SWITCH PLATES

Replace all plastic receiptical and switch plates with antique brass of turn of the century vintage. Available from Renovators Supply.

9) LANTERN ROOM

Open up lantern room for guided tours. Second docent will open tower gate for guided small group access.

10) YARD AND GARDEN

Provide plants and garden to beautify entrance to Lighthouse.

11) DOOR LATCHES

Strip paint from brass rimlock door latches, coat with clear lacquer
or varnish.
