GUIDELINES FOR DONATIONS

We are committed to preserving the history of the Point Pinos Lighthouse so that today's visitor can understand and enjoy the story of the oldest lighthouse structure on the Pacific Coast.

We are interested in acquiring objects that enable us to tell that story. If you have an item that you believe would be appropriate in our collection, and would like to donate it to the lighthouse, please take a moment to read the following guidelines. Thank you for your interest.

Acquisition Guidelines:

The item must be consistent with and relevant to the scope and activities of the lighthouse.

It does not duplicate objects already in the collection.

It is sufficiently well documented that it can be interpreted for the visitor.

The donor must possess clear title to the item.

Limitations and Restrictions:

All acquisitions are outright and unconditional.

Subject to space limitations, not all items will be placed on display at any given time.

All potential donations to the collection must be preceded by the application on the form on the reverse side.

Appraisals for tax or other purposes are the donor's responsibility.
