		Mariner's Compass, 2 slight vanes, gimbal ring and box with top. Brass or copper or plated. Glass on top set in with sealing wax. Around center of compass card is Jaquier, Poullieur and Fr de Compas, A. Dunquerque. Fleur de lis marks North; other points around card are NE, E, SE, S, SO, O, NO. Degrees are in tens from 0-north to 90-east to 0-south to 90-west to 0-north. Compass card is approx. 3" down from glass. Lubber's line has been cut in glass. Top edge of compass has 2 notches to hold the brass sight vanes which are approx. 3.5" high. There are also 2 other rounded metal pieces on the top edge. The compass is hung in a gimbal ring approx. 10.5" in diam. which is hung in a box. The box of Honduras mahogany measures 8.875" high x 11.875" square. Two sides of the box curve up to hold screws holding gimbal ring. On the very bottom of the compass is a rounded metal disk approx. 3.5" in diam. in the center of which is a brass knob which probably releases and fastens the compass card. Oak rocker with spindle back, armless. Across top is a rectangle with a carving of a grape vine.
